4. स्तोत्राणि stotrāṇi = Hymns in Samskṛtam devoted to Incarnations and Devatās with word by word translations in English.

5. वैदिक vaidika - In this section Vedic Nārāyaṇasūktam is included

with word by word English translation, and an article on age of श्रीकृष्ण Śrīkṛṣṇa and महाभारत mahābhārata war.
