अ a (a as woman). आ ā (ā as in all),

इ i (i as in it), ई ī (ī sounds as in eat),

उ u (u as in put), ऊ ū (ū as in room)

ए e (e as in where), ऐ ai (ai as kite or ripe)

ओ o (o as in go or as in boat), औ au (au as in house or mouse)

ऋ = r̥ (r̥ as in Kṛ shṇa), अं = am̐, अः = aḥ

क = ka, (ka as in king), ख = kha (kha is the aspirated sound of ka)

ग = ga (ga as in good girl), घ = gha (gha is the aspirated sound of ga)

ङ = ṅa (ṅa sound like ng as in ring, king),

च = ca (ca as in chair), छ = cha (cha is the aspirated sound of ca)

ज = ja (ja as in jungle), झ = jha (jha is the aspirated sound of ja)

ञ = ña (ña as in Soṅya or पञ्च pañca = means five in Sanskritam.)

ट = ṭa (ṭa as in tool or timber), ठ = ṭha (ṭha is the aspirated sound of ṭa)

ड = ḍa (ḍa as in dog or dig), ढ = ḍha (ḍha is the aspirated sound of ḍa)

ण = ṇa (ṇa sound is not in the English vocabulary), like in word Brahmaṇa.

त = ta (ta as thing or thumb), थ = tha (tha is the aspirated sound of ta)

द = da (as in the or there), ध = dha (dha is aspirated sound of da)

न = na (na as in nail or name)

प = pa (pa as in pen), फ = pha (pha is the aspirated sound of pa)

ब = ba (ba as in ball), भ = bha (bha is aspirated sound of ba)

म = ma (ma as in mother)

य = ya (ya as in yellow), र = ra (ra as real or ready),

ल = la (la as in love), व = va (va as in valley or as in Victor)

श = śa (śa as in Śhiva), ष = ṣa (ṣa as in rush), स = sa (sa as in sun)

ह = ha (ha as in hall or hill), क्ष = kṣa (kṣa as in Lakṣmi or kṣatriya)

रामं (ī as in rāmam) ṁ (ṁ as chum) is called *anusvāra*.

ऽ ' This symbol is called *avagraha* which represents (½ अ) and is

employed to mark elision of a short अ a after (ए e or ओ o)

Examples (1) ते + अपि = तेऽपि or te + api = is written as te'pi and is pronounced as tepi means: **They also**.

(2) कालः + अस्ति = कालो + अस्ति = कालोऽस्ति
kālaḥ+asti = kālo + asti = kālo'sti and is pronounced as kālosti means: **Time is**.

(3) नमः + अस्तु + ते = नमो + अस्तु + ते = नमोऽस्तुते

namaḥ + astu + te = namo + astu + te = namo'stute
and as is pronounced as namostute means: **Salutations to
you.**
